DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Although this structure has been heavily altered for commercial purposes some original fabric remains.

The L-shaped main block is a two story frame structure resting on a stone foundation approximately 15" off of the ground. The sides appear to have been originally covered with clapboards, and are topped by a gable-end roof. The main block is four bays wide and one bay deep with a gabled-end projection (wing) to the south. The fenestration is regular with 6/6 sash windows.

A rather large chimney cap exits the roof west of the center and south of the ridge.

Particular features include rectangular louvered vents in the gable ends, and louvered shutters set off by wooden lintels.

The interior space has been totally reconstructed for commercial purposes.



