SEDLACK HOUSE - 1912 - 200 West Pennsylvania Avenue, Towson. Part of a row of cottages developed by Harrison Rider and shown as his in 1915 atlas. Acquired by Joseph Sedlack in 19__ and was home and residence of Dr. Sedlack. In 1978, acquired by present owner and adapted into legal office space. A louvered cupola was added to ridge line in January of 1979. Frame, two story, gable roofed house with aluminum siding covering original clapboarding. Colonial Revival style. The anchor building of a law office neighborhood to be called the Inns of Court. Owner: Thomas G. Tinsley.
