DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Young house is a shingle style house of about 1910, one story with a very high gambrel roof providing a usable second story. There are large gambrel dormers centered front and rear. The plan is a large square with an addition at rear and a shed-roof porch on the front. Proportions are broad, generally, especially those of the 8/8 windows. Double doors with late Victorian glazing (a large rectangular surface of glass with four intersecting muntins creating a central pane with border strips and corner panes) let onto the porch. The entrance doors were similar, but one of the glazed doors has been replaced with a panel door.




