FOLLY QUARTER - Early 1700s - 6600 Deer Park Road, 0.8 mile west of Ivy Mill Road. Also called Mount Pleasant Farm, this 1-½ story log and frame house was built in Soldiers Delight barrens by John Boseman, a settler from Virginia. His sons patented 3,000 acres in the area in 1731. House said to have been a place of worship before Garrison Forest Church was established. Extensive frame and stone additions made in 1770, 1800, 1944. Also a building claimed to be a private fort or refuge. Present name adopted 1954. Owners (since 1956): Mr. and Mrs. John Donaho. See Gardens, Houses & People, June 1957, p. 31.
