Description

2726 RAILROAD AVENUE is a two storey frame house, originally a duplex, four bays in length. A one-storey hipped-roof porch extends across its principal or south front. Interior chimneys, each a single flue, are at each gable end. Entrances are in both middle bays; 6/6 windows are in the two outer bays and in all four bays of the second storey. A two storey service wing extends to the north. Exterior walls are covered with asbestos shingles. The interior of this house was not examined.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Significance

2716 RAILROAD AVENUE, dating from the second half of the nineteenth century, is a traditional duplex dwelling wholly unaffected by current styles.

Elizabeth A. and Robert L. Price Jr. have held this 2 storey frame house since April 30, 1973.¹ Many persons have held possession of this lot over the years. The property includes two lots numbered 4 and 5 as shown in a map drawn up by Thomas Disney in 1908.²

Lot #4 was granted to Robert C. and Eliza Price by Robert A. Green in 1924.³ In 1908 Josephine L. Stewart conveyed all of lot 5 to Robert Green⁴. The 1918 tax roll assessed Robert Green for both lots 4 and 5 describing them as " a lot 100 by 225 feet on the Green Spring branch of the Northern Central Railroad, 75 feet East from Valley Raod adjacent to the Colored Methodist Church". The lot was valued at \$400 while the house was assessed at \$750.⁵

Both lots with buildings conveyed to Charles Morton Stewart by John Bowen Sr. in 1872.⁶



