**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

The Amanda Moore House is a two story frame semi-detached residence topped with a gable roof. The walls appear to be covered with aluminum siding, however the foundation material was not determined. The structure measures four bays wide and one bay deep. The fenestration is symmetrical with 6/6 sash windows and an entrance door in each of the outer bays. A full single story hipped roof porch covers the main facade and is supported by brick piers.

The interior was not examined.



