NOTT'S MILL - 1918-1923 - Upper Beckleysville Road (renamed Gunpowder Mill about 1977) near Clipper Mill Road. A miniature gristmill or feed mill, 14 by 15 feet, three stories, of weathered board. Shown at the spot occupied in the 1877 atlas by the Valentine Bollinger sawmill. However, this structure was put up sometime after 1918 when the father of the present owner (1980s) bought the Bollinger farm at auction. George C. Nott acquired the property after it was advertised in the Jeffersonian shortly before an auction held on March 25, 1918; the farm was advertised with a dwelling, and new bank barn, but no mill.

The present owner, Mr. William W. Nott told local historian C.E. Clemens that he had helped his father build the mill. The mill was apparently the "other building" listed in the 1923 tax ledger for the first time, valued at \$500. Before the publication of John McGrain's gristmill book, in 1980, Mr. Clemens had picked up the story that square dances were held in the tiny mill. Mr. Nott later explained that there was a separate wooden dance hall (first listed in the 1940-1946 tax ledger), now demolished.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE (Include Personages, Dates, Events, Etc.)

This very small mill is shown in the Hopkins 1877 atlas as Valentine Bollingers Sawmill. It is located on Upper Beckleysville Road on a stream above Grave Run and Below Rockdale. No house is nearby.

6th District.

This property passed to George C. Nott in 1918 via assignee of its mortgage, John Mays Little. Thomas E. and Emmeline E. Bollinger had mortgaged the property to the Manchester Savings Bank in 1909. Thomas E. Bollinger was deeded the property by Valentine Bollinger in 1884, Liber WMI No. 136, f. 510. Valentine Bollinger had acquired the property under two deeds, (1) from John S. Hoover and wife, April 19, 1879, JB No. 108, f. 59, and (2) from Joseph Bollinger and wife, JB No. 112, f. 308. None of these deeds mention the mill although water rights are mentioned in a deed from George C. Nott to William W. Nott in 1942, CHK No. 1250, f. 455. The stream is merely called "the little branch."


