early 1700s

Located on the north side of the road, opposite Mt. Paran Church, the Worthington-Struven house is deep in the estate property. This was a standard vernacular-style stone cabin which was in this century much enlarged. The roof pitch was changed and the roof moved out about 10 feet to make another room. Dormers were added, and the old original rafters removed. The present owner, Mrs. Helen L. Struven, added a "flat dormer" to admit light to her art studio. The house is now 1 1/2 stories with a kitchen wing. In 1981, the stone core measured 33'9" by 18.5'. The depth of the cabin portion, including a wooden rear extension, is a total of 29' 3".
