ENSOR MILL (SITE) - c. 1805 - Piney Run and eastside of Ensor Mill Road. "Gorsuch's Mill Lot" was surveyed in 1797. Original mill was built about 1805 by Dickinson Gorsuch and passed into Ensor family. The 22 x 78 foot building of stone and wood was inhabited by tenants until it burned in January 1969. The remaining walls were subsequently demolished. A saw-milling operation continued in 1977, conducted by Dewey Widener. A tennis court complex was planned for the Ensor Farm House property in 1978.
