The present David house was built about 1918 as an additional structure on the properties of William H. Whetcraft, who had a larger house adjoining on the north. Originally listed in the tax ledger as a 13 by 16-foot, one-story dwelling, it served for 38 years as the residence of John Gonser, who was apparently a single man. William H. and Naomi Stiffler acquired the house in 1958. It has been subsequently enlarged by a frame wing that presents a 6-light picture window to the York Road. This is a plain, vernacular style, frame structure covered with white composition shingles.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The David House is a small, plain, one-story, vernacular style structure of three elements: main block, rear wing, and south wing. It first appeared on the tax records as a 13 by 16-foot dwelling apparently sufficient for the single man who lived there for 38 years. The house was subsequently enlarged with a much smarter-looking southern wing.

The older portion of the house presents its gable end to the road and is two bays wide on the east or road facade. The windows are recent aluminum-framed replacements of 1-over-1 layout. At attic level, the gable peak window is a full-sized sash window of 1-over-1 format similar to those at first-floor level. The north wall of the main block is without windows, but in the low, one-story rear kitchen wing, there is a single 1-over-1 sash window in the north wall.

The south wing presents a large, 6-pane picture window to the street.

Roofing is of two types and generations of rubber shingle material. The eaves overhang slightly on each of the three roof areas.

Outer wall covering is white composition shingle.
