The property documented in the following MIHP form has been demolished, per Teri Rising, Baltimore County Department of Planning Preservation Services Division (see 1/26/15 e-mail and report on file in Registrar's office).

**SMALL VALLEY** - Before 1877 - 9200 Satyr Hill Road, opposite terminus of Smith Avenue. Frame house in Victorian style, four bays wide, two stories, with gable roof and inside end chimneys; cross-gabled roof. This is apparently a replacement of some of the frame houses listed as Francis Towson's in 1798 tax list. Tract name is Small Valley, and in 1845, Lot 5 of Obidiah Towson's former land passed to John W. Shanklin, Sr., who lived until 1883. It appears as Towson's in 1877 atlas. Acquired by James H. Gordon in 1905. Dimensions given as 32 x 16 in 1918 tax list.
