The Dining Hall and Kitchen Building is a one-and-one-half story, flat-roofed stone building located north-east of the Power Plant at Rosewood Center. The main entrance is at the center of the east facade and has a pedimented portico supported on square Doric piers. The building was completed in 1938; the architect was Henry Powell Hopkins.

The Dining Hall and Kitchen Building, built in 1938 is a one-and-one-half-story, flat-roofed stone building located north-east of the Power Plant at Rosewood Center.

The building consists of a main one-and-one-half-story block, ten bays long and three bays wide which is flanked on either side by a one story wing, ten bays long and one bay wide. It is constructed of variegated cut stone with smooth-faced cut stone used for the projecting window sills and the jack-arche above the windows. The north and south faces of the second story are covered with stucco. There are 12/12 sash windows on the first story and nine-pane fixed sash windows on the second story.

The main entrance is at the center of the east facade and has a pedimented portico supported on square Doric piers.

The interior although greatly altered, has plastered walls in the dining room, brick walls in the kitchen.


The Dining Hall and Kitchen Building was constructed in 1938 to the design of the architect Henry Powell Hopkins.

Hopkins executed several important commissions for the State in the 1930s and 1940s including buildings at Springfield State Hospital, the University of Maryland and was responsible for the remodelling and restoration of the Old Treasury Building and State Office Buildings in Annapolis. A well known architect practicing in the Georgian Revival style, Hopkins usually produced designs for buildings in brick, but probably decided that the Kitchen Building should be of stone construction to harmonize with the earlier buildings.


