
BOWERS HOUSE - Before 1850 - 433 Kendig Mill Road, Owings Mills. Small, undecorated one-story frame cottage that housed the owners of the Snavely-Reese-Kendig Mill. The house was shown in the 1850 Sidney map. The mill stopped running in 1937; it gradually decayed, partly brought down by the 1942 "Palm Sunday" blizzard, leaving only a pit by the 1960s. The owner of the house in 1986, Mrs. Abraham Bowers, was the daughter of the last miller, David L. Kendig.
