



FOREMAN'S HOUSE: COPPERWORKS - ca. 1815 - 10734 Harford Road east of Factory Road. Small stone house in vernacular style; two stories with a large shed dormer added later. This is identified by local expert Maurice O. Brown as foreman's house at the Gunpowder Copper Works, the best of the dwellings. Acquired by Baltimore City for water supply project but not needed; sold to Henry A. Reier in 1877; in his family until 1938. Vernacular style; similar to Welsh or English factory town architecture. Owner: John R. Engle. (Deeds 3557:560).
