

BALTIMORE COUNTY BANK - 1926 - 500 York Road, Towson. Large two-story squarish fieldstone bank with flat roof. Bronze doors. Ground was broken in July 1925 and the bank opened for business on March 27, 1926. George Norbury Mackenzie was architect and William H. Sands contractor. The architectural rendering appeared in Jeffersonian, August 22, 1926. This bank failed during the great Depression. It is now a branch of the Maryland National Bank.
