POPLAR GROVE - ca. 1859 - 5113 Rolling Road, Relay. Perry G. Mitchell acquired this ground from Samuel Sutton in 1855. The 1859 updates in the District 1 transfer book showed P. G. Mitchell with \$6,000 in new "dwelling and out-buildings." Two Perry G. Mitchell houses were mentioned in the Md. Journal, July 29, 1871. Large, rambling frame house shown as one of two mansions of Perry G. Mitchell in 1877 atlas, on 5½ acre tract called "Poplar Grove." Shown as C. F. Throop's on Plate 8 of Bromley's 1898 atlas. Gable-roofed with a variety of porches, pavilions, and cross-gables, and lunette windows. Good condition in 1988 photo. Owner: Wendy L. Tolley.
