9201 Samoset is individually eligible under criteria C for architecture as a noteworthy example of victorian residential architecture. This large structure, prominently located on its site, exhibits Queen Ann detailing and was most likely constructed between 1880 and 1900. This large two story frame structure of intersecting gable roofs retains many of its characteristic features including a large porch with turned posts and decorative brackets at the first floor front elevation and turned posts and a decorative spindle frieze at the second floor front porch. The shingled gables and large porte cochere are also distinctive original features of the structure.
