Description of Property and Eligibility Determination: *(Use continuation sheet if necessary and attach map and photo)*

The Snell House is a single family dwelling constructed in 1930. The exterior is covered with rock-faced stone laid in regular courses and has a front gable roof of asphalt shingles. A shed roof dormer covered with vinyl siding expresses the interior second floor space. The windows are 6 over 1 in the dormers, 3 over 1 in the first floor, and the fenestration expresses the traditional Arts and Crafts pattern: three windows and then two joined together. There is a one-story addition to which a carport has been added.

The house is within the Woodmor subdivision, a large development of houses constructed in 1955. As a result, the Snell house is an isolated example of the Arts and Crafts style. At the same time, it appears that the rock siding is not the original covering. Based on the lack of integrity of workmanship, materials, setting, and location, as well as its lack of significance under Criterion C, the Snell House is not eligible for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places. No research was done to determine eligibility under Criterion D, and research has not revealed eligibility under Criteria A or B.






