Description of Property and Eligibility Determination: *(Use continuation sheet if necessary and attach map and photo)*

The Brian Jones Dwelling is a one-and-a-half story, three bay, side gable house with an exterior chimney, two gable dormers, and a center hall entry. The replacement windows are one over one, and there is a three-part window in the living room. There is a carport addition on the south side of the building.

The house is a common type found in all areas of Baltimore County. One of three houses built near the intersection of Washington Avenue and Liberty Road, it lacks distinctive architectural features and therefor is not eligible for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places under Criterion C. Additional research has not revealed associations with events or persons important to Maryland's history (Criteria A and B). No research was performed to identify significance under Criterion D.




