


Description of Property and Eligibility Determination: *(Use continuation sheet if necessary and attach map and photo)*

The Javed House, located at 7802 Liberty Road, is an example of a Tudor Revival style house. It is a one-and-a-half-story frame house with a side gable, asphalt shingle roof, three bays wide, with a center hall entrance and a projecting bay and two large frame windows on each side of the entrance. A stone and brick chimney is built in the front. The exterior sheathing is brick with decorative stucco accented with wood and brick trim in the front gable. In the rear, a shed roof gable dormer extends across the roof.

Although Baltimore County land records indicate that this house may be less than 50 years of age, stylistically it is associated with the Tudor Revival houses then built in the 1930s and also is an example of the minimal houses first financed by the Federal Government. Based on that information, the house is dated to the 1940s. Furthermore, while the house displays Tudor Revival elements, it lacks such elements as a steep "cat slide" roof, arched door, and multi-pane, divided light windows.

The Javed House is an example of an isolated suburban building. The houses which surround it are all of post-1951 construction. The adjacent properties do not enhance the Javed House or provide it with an adequate architectural context. As a result, the Javed Property is not eligible for inclusion in the Nation Register of Historic Places under Criterion C. Although the house has some association with local transportation history, the house is not sufficiently linked to this history and therefore is not eligible under Criterion A. Research indicates that no person of importance is associated with the building (Criterion B) and no research was performed to determine eligibility under Criterion D.




