Based on the information provided, 600 Winters Lane appears to be a contributing resource in the National Register eligible West Catonsville Historic District. Located at the northern end of the district, 600 Winters Lane is a modest frame house, probably dating to the turn-of-the-century, which is typical of the architecture of the West Catonsville neighborhood. The district is eligible under criteria A and C, as representative collection of residential and commercial architecture illustrating the Baltimore area's development of stylistic and vernacular buildings in the late 19th and early 20th century and as a black community first settled in the late 1860s by freed blacks and continuously associated with that community's development.


