
4. NOTABLE FEATURES, HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE AND DESCRIPTION OPEN TO PUBLIC **no**

A variation of the Luterville cottage, this shingled house presents a symmetrical five bay facade characterized by a typical front attic gable with a heavy barge board moulding. The gable contains a pair of rectangular casement windows with a transom separated with wide mullions set within a narrow trimmed frame.

The one story verands is carried on round Tuscan type columns and extends beyond each end of the front facade onto the end elevations stopping at two story bay windows.

A central sidelighted and transomed, paneled front door is flanked by two elongated two over two sash at each side. Standard height two over two sash were used at the second floor windows. All windows except for those of the bay windows and the attic glables are hung with louvered shutters.
