

4. NOTABLE FEATURES, HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE AND DESCRIPTION OPEN TO PUBLIC

Produced from the typical Lutherville mould, this shingled house with its front, central attic gable at a right angle to the main roof ridge has three bays at the second floor level and an unusual four bays at the first floor level behind the one story porch. The porch is supported on shingled columns set on a shingled balustrade and has a moulded cornice at the eaves of the half hipped roof. Opening onto the porch is the paneled front door with one window bay to the north and two window bays to the south. The second floor windows are set directly over the end first floor windows with the central window under a diamond shaped window in the attic gable which has shingling projecting slightly beyond the lower wall surface.


The sash is typically six over six lights set in narrow trim similar in character to the unmoulded eaves and rakes.
