COLDURHOL FARM - LACEY HOUSE - 1879 - 4014 Perry Hall Road, north side, 0.25 mile west of Belair Road. Large, Victorian, cross-gabled house built of coursed rubble stone; named "Coldurhol" farm for its specialties: collie dogs, duroc hogs, and Holstein cattle. Constructed by stonemason Conrad Weis. Matilda C. Lacey was founder of Baltimore County Historical Society in 1959. The extinct "slave jail" that had belonged to Perry Hall mansion stood on this farm until 1913.
