POT SPRING FARM HOUSE - 1775-1800 - No. 1836 Pot Spring Road at NW corner with Timonium Road. Two-story stone house in vernacular style, formed by uniting two separate structures. The stone houses were supposedly the slave cabins of the large Pot Spring mansion. The house was modernized after 1935 purchase by William C. Stettinius. Later owned by Warrington Smith. Further restoration carried out by present owners. The stone portions do not match the houses charged to David McMechen in 1798 tax list. Owner: Mrs. Don Diffenderfer.
