Located on the north side of Monkton Road, on the west side of the former NCRR line, this one-story frame depot has vertical board-and-batten siding with late Victorian bracketed eaves, and a shed-roofed dormer and eyebrow window. The building was sold off by the NCRR in 1960, the year after passenger service ended. The property owner is listed as Thomas G. McCausland.
