Bacon House

South side of Monkton Road,

0.05 mile east of intersection with Piney Hill Road

This large stone, two-story vernacular style house has a gable roof, and is set on high ground. A house shown here on the 1850 map was Martin Bacon's "Monkton View." However, the early transfer book shows Martin Bacon with a new "Stone House" worth \$3,000 in 1859. The 1877 atlas showed this as John Bacon's residence.
