Blacksmith Shop, Trentham Property (site)
east side of Reisterstown Road
0.45 mile NW of McDonough Road intersection
Owings Mills

This building appears on the 1877 Hopkins atlas as a smithy. An old photo shows Charles B. Morgan as its occupant. The building stood opposite the extinct Ten Mile House (BA-42). Built of stone, the one story building measured 23 x 38 feet. It was rented out by Miss Sallie Cradock to Lisa Atkinson as a tea room and gift shop. The hearth and chimney were intact in 1974, but the roof was partially fallen. This shop is not found on the 1798 tax list, but Dawn F. Thomas in The Green Spring Valley quotes Cradock family papers showing a blacksmith shop rented out to a tenant operator in 1797. It was demolished in August of 1978.
