The house was probably built after 1894 when Tjark B. Susemihl and his wife acquired a 3-acre lot here. They sold it to William P. Hudson in 1919. No house is shown here in the 1915 atlas, although it is listed in the 1896 tax ledger. Dimensions for this building on the 1918 tax ledger were 14 x 28', 14 x 32', and 6 x 15'. The location was then called Easter Avenue.

A late Victorian frame house covered with white composition shingles, it is 2 1/2 stories tall. It has dormers facing the road, and others on the west side of the tin gable roof. There is also a shed roof on a back building. One stained-glass window faces the road. The owner was listed as C. LeRoy Widerman.
