Rectangular, two story, three bay, frame with aluminum siding, side gable, balloon frame, detached dwelling with a central chimney, a flat-roofed full width porch with modern metal roof supports and single story side and rear addition.

The alterations described above, including replacement (or covering over) of the original siding and the addition of a modern porch and modern wings, have obscured the historic character of this mid-nineteenth century, vernacular dwelling.

This house is recorded as the E. Beck House on G. M. Hopkins' 1877 Atlas of Baltimore County, as the A. Tase on George and Walter Bromley's Atlas of Baltimore County of 1898 and as J. M. Easter's house on the 1915 Atlas of Baltimore County. This small, vernacular house is a good example of a common mid-nineteenth century house type. However, its integrity has been compromised and thus its significance undermined, as a result of incompatible, twentieth century alterations and additions.


