

**ANNANDALE** - 1838-50 - East side of Reisterstown Road inside Druid Ridge Cemetery. Large stone and stucco house with full width front porch, gable roof, and wide inside-end-chimneys; also partial side porches. House was built between 1838 and 1850 by George Reinecker in a Victorian style. It was H. Reinecker house of 1850 map and the Charles K. Harrison house of 1877 atlas. Harrison sold in 1894 to Charles Tyler, who sold in 1897 to the cemetery company. A plat of 1913 shows a Victorian 2-½ story house with both cross-gable and dormers, located on Vista Avenue of the cemetery driveway plan. See 1881 drawing in Scharf's history of the county (p. 846.) The variation in appearance was caused by a fire of 1915 that burned the top story and damaged the second. The house was remodeled as the cemetery superintendent's residence.
