- BA-730 **SACRED HEART R.C. CHURCH** - 1873 - Sacred Heart Lane. Cornerstone ceremony took place November 29, 1873. Contractor was J.J. Shorb and Son of Westminster. Original dimensions were 30 by 70. Land was donated by P. Dyer of Reisterstown. Small stone church in Victorian Gothic revival, gable roof, bell tower, buttresses. Excellent condition.
- BA-731 **KEHNE HOUSE** - Before 1915 - 405 Chatsworth Avenue. Frame, 2-story, Victorian house with both clapboard and shingle covering, gable roof, stone foundation; poor condition, 1978. This was the J.H. Penn house in 1915 atlas. Owner: Clyde W. Kehne.
- BA-732 **HARRIS HOUSE** - Before 1915 - 407 Chatsworth Avenue. Rambling frame house covered with clapboard and wood shingle; Victorian style, gable roof; stone foundation. Excellent condition. Shown as J.T. Kelley's in 1915 Bromley atlas. Owner: Norman G. Harris.
- BA-733 **DEFLORA HOUSE** - Before 1915 - 733 Chatsworth Avenue. Large, frame and clapboard, 2-½ story house in Queen Anne style; gable roof; stone foundation; excellent condition. Shown next to John Dyer's property in 1915 Bromley atlas. The 1918 tax ledger listed John J. Dyer with a house 300 feet west of the railroad; measurements were 22 x 28 and 11 x 24; he also owned a Chandler auto. Owner: R.J. DeFlora.
- BA-734 **SMITH HOUSE** - Before 1915 - 2 Chatsworth Avenue. Shown in 1915 atlas as home of Geo. Penn, who first kept a store and then became a horse and buggy rural letter carrier. Victorian style house, frame and wood shingles, with gable roof and brick foundation. Owner: Elsie P. Smith.
- BA-735 **IMM HOUSE** - Before 1898 - 8 Chatsworth Avenue. Shown in 1898 and 1915 atlas plates as James Penn's. Victorian style house in frame and wood shingle; gable roof, brick foundation. Owner: Robert O. Imm.
- BA-736 **ABBOTT HOUSE** - Before 1898 - 12 Chatsworth Avenue. Shown in 1898 atlas as Mrs. Eckman's and in 1915 as Dawson house. Victorian frame and clapboard house with gable roof, stone foundation. Owner: Arthur W. Abbott.
