BA-764 **BUTLER HOUSE** - Before 1915 - South side of Bond Avenue. Shown in 1915 atlas as G.W. Arnold's. Frame and clapboard house in Queen Anne style, gable roof, stone foundation. Owner: Caroline Butler.

BA-765 **CRANE HOUSE** - Before 1877 - South side of Bond Avenue opposite terminus of Central Avenue. Shown in 1877 atlas as MI. Gore's, in 1898 as William Dalany's, and in 1915 as J. Gore's. Frame house demolished in 1970s by suburban housing project. Last private owner was Leon A. Crane.

BA-766 **LAWSON HOUSE** - Before 1915 - North side of Bond Road, east of Central Avenue. Shown in 1915 atlas as house of the Misses Warner. Queen Anne style house, frame and clapboard, with hip roof, stone foundation. Owner: William Clayton Lawson.

BA-767 **CHARLES ECKHARDT HOUSE** - Before 1915 - 329 Central Avenue. Shown in 1915 atlas as F. Eckhardt's. Frame, Queen Ann style house in clapboard and shingle with hip roof, stone foundation. Owner: Charles Eckhardt's.

BA-768 **HANNAH HOUSE** - c. 1892-95 - 325 Central Avenue, Glyndon. Shown as F. Eckhardt house in 1915 atlas. Frame house in Victorian style with composition shingling, gable roof, and stone foundation. Owner: John M. O'Meara.

BA-769 **SKIPPER HOUSE** - 1878 - 317 Central Avenue. Shown in 1898 atlas and 1915 version as home of Nicholas H. Fishbaugh, carpenter and the original owner and builder. Frame house covered with composition shingles, Victorian style; gable roof; stone foundation. Owner: Betty Jane Skipper.

BA-770 **PETTINGILL HOUSE** - Before 1898 - 315 Central Avenue. Shown in 1898 and 1915 atlases as Dr. H. Smith's. Frame house with composition shingles; Queen Anne style, gable roof, stone foundation. Owner: Lee D. Pettingill.

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
