WEBSTER BOSLEY'S LOG HOUSE - 1800-1850 - North side of Gerber Lane, 0.3 mile NE of Western Run Road. Apparently the A.S. Gerber house of 1877 atlas. Two-part house in vernacular style consisting of a 2-bay, 2-story, 17 x 18 foot log section covered with wood shingles and a late 19th-Century wing covered with German siding, in turn covered with asbestos shingles. Stone cellar and foundations; log joists support floor in older portion (c. 1800). Gable roofing covered with standing-seam tin. Does not fit 1798 dimensions of Mordecai Cole house. Vacant in 1976.
