DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Only a stone chimney remains of Aunt Ellie's House, formerly a small dwelling, probably of log construction. A fireplace is in its first storey, facing northwest. The single flue is enclosed in a massively-proportioned stack, in size only slightly reduced from the firebox enclosure. Stovepipe holes are added in the first storey above the fireplace, in the second and attic storeys. The chimney surfaces formerly exposed within the house are plastered and the back side of the chimney is rough, indicating its having been an interior end chimney. A massive roughly-worked stone spans the firebox opening.
