LONG GREEN STATION - c. 1882 - North side of Long Green Road, 0.5 mile west of Long Green Pike. Former Maryland and Pennsylvania passenger station. Two-story clapboarded structure now covered with green asbestos shingles. Hip roof. All rail service terminated in 1958. Converted into a dwelling. Formerly called "Gittings", this station was approached by a bridge over Long Green Road. Also a frame baggage shed. Owner: Robert B. Deford.
