This two-story framed and weatherboarded house faces southwest onto the Patuxent River and Patuxent Avenue. Set on a low brick foundation, it is a cross-gable house with the three-bay facade in the gable end of one wing. It has a side-passage plan. The original windows are glazed with two-over-two double-hung sash. Some of the windows have been changed to single-pane double-hung sash. There are interior brick chimneys. The one-story hipped-roof porch is supported on Doric columns. It shelters both the facade and the southeast side of the house. Part of it is screened in. The fenestration of the facade has been changed to include a side doorway and one broad picture window. This house looks very much like the Abel House (CT-899) on Solomons Island Road. There is an original cast and wrought-iron fence delineating the edge of the front yard.


