

Mrs. Susan Swann, who celebrated her 100th birthday in 1972, was born in this house. Once called River Farm, the property was owned by Mrs. Swann's maternal grandfather, William C. Fowler, before 1868.

Mrs. Swann's birthplace was torn down in 1977. The plain two-story L-shaped frame farmhouse stood on the banks of the Patuxent River. A barn, perhaps of the same age as the house, survives.
