DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Numerous additions and alterations obscure the original exterior appearance of this house, and an opportunity to examine the interior has not been had.

It can be seen in the accompanying photographs that in its original state; the house was a two-story cross gable not terribly unlike its neighbor across the road at the Levels Farm. The central pediments have approximately the same pitch and are vented by the same little 2/2 square window. The rest of the house appears to have had tall 2/2 windows. Clapboards covered the frame structure on the exterior, and the gable end roof appears to have been resurfaced. A metal roof, possibly cartwright shingles, would have not been uncommon.

Interior flue chimneys occupy either end of the house.






