DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Replacing an earlier structure, this house was built C. 1912 by Albert J. Bowen. This is according to an interview with Albert J. Bowen's son J. who is 81 years old. A. J. Bowen had a store which faced Route 231, the summer kitchen behind the house was constructed from materials salvaged during the stores demolition.

The house is bays wide and has an I-plan. The swell front and central gable give it an immediate Victorian appearance. The character of that age is furthered by an interior which includes walnut mantles with fluted corunthian columns and sways, corner moldings with pendants and bulls-eye corner blocks. The plan provides for double parlors flanking a central entrance hall. In addition to the stairway, the hall is made somewhat elegant by the frosted glass door with sidelights and transom.

An early 20th Century tobacco barn is on the property. It is unusual for its size; it is a small six room barn to which Mr. Sedwick Bowen added another six rooms.


