DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Mr. Gurley Hance is seventy-nine years old and has lived around Mutual and Prince Frederick all his life. He has lived in this house since 1946 and remembers the house being here in 1908. According to Mr. Hance, two brothers with the last name of Bowen built next to each other with this house and its neighbor to the south being the result.

Mr. Hance has added the two-sided porch and the two-story addition in the rear (West). Prior to then, this was obviously a smaller house with a longitudinal plan. The entrance is on the north side of the east gable end. The stairs to the second floor are located in the same corner and are lighted by an unusual diamond shape window on the second floor.

Underneath the asbestos shingles is the original clapboard siding. The gable-end roof probably had sheet metal roofing in its original state.

The original plan provided for a parlor and a dining room downstairs. Mr. Hance says that the house had a single story kitchen addition on the rear which was "falling down" when he bought the house. It was replaced by the modern addition. There are now three bedrooms upstairs where there once was two.








