**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

A fire, disuse and modern times have left the farm known as Mount Misery a site with only one historic structure left and it is altered. According to the owner, gone are the main house, corn house, black smithy, and a tobacco barn. Materials from these structures have been saved. The outline of a subterranean ice house was visible beneath debris and vines. Many repairs are evident but the large tobacco barn contains the frame of the original barn. It has a post and beam frame with mortise, tenon and trunneled joints. It was a typical three part plan. It retains continuous plates. Its siding and shingles have been removed.

Indian artifacts are said to have been found in the fields near the house.



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
