DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This simple frame farmhouse faces Rt. 4 to the west. The two-story building includes two one-story additions--an enclosed porch on the west and a shed kitchen on the east.

A central stove flue rises from the north-south gable roof. The house measures two bays long by one bay deep. Its 1/1 windows are framed in plain flat boards. Brown imitation-brick asphalt sheathes the house.

A frame tobacco barn stands northeast of the dwelling. Several sheds east of the house complete the farmstead.




