DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This structure is a two story, three bay by one bay frame cross-gabled farmhouse with German siding. The windows are set well in from the end wall and have 6/6 sash. In the central cross-gable is a small arched window. The main entrance is located in the center bay of the front elevation and includes a transom and sidelights.

A one-story wing extends to the rear and a hip footed porch supported by plain posts is attached to the front elevation.

Mrs. Ford, who was raised in the house, says there is a full attic and basement, a set of stairs in the front and one in the rear. The small front upstairs room with the small, arched window has been turned into a bathroom. There was one bedroom for the girls, and one for the boys, and the southeast corner bedroom was their parents' room.

She and her husband hope to fix the house up soon, as it is the family homeplace. Some of the wooden siding is rotten and needs replacing, and the whole thing could use scraping and painting. Several people have tried to sell them aluminum siding upon seeing the condition of the house.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This is a typical Calvert County farmhouse and is of no particular significance.

James Leroy King and Mabel I. King bought this farm from the Hall family. They raised 7 children there. One daughter, Mrs. Ford, lives with her retired husband in a trailer next to the home. Mrs. King is in her nineties, and is in a wheelchair. The Fords have arranged a wooden ramp in front of the door so that she can get out. Mr. King died about 30 years ago.

A small, white house across the street, at the end of the driveway to Harmony Hill, is called "Poseys," and is where Mrs. King came to live as a 15-year-old bride.

The house is not, nor has it ever been, owned by Calvert Meats, Inc., which is the name of a company across the street in a modern building.


