STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This is a typical Calvert County farmhouse of no particular significance.

Chris and Harry Hill bought this farm from Dorothy Chaney, the widow of Wilson Chaney. The Chaney family once owned all the property from here to MD Route 2, about 1/2 mile to the east. The Chaney children each built homes on this property, dividing it up between the three of them. Georgie owned the first house (then) to the east, then Edith the next, and finally Alan the last one before Route 2 (the house is now CT-336).


