Late 19th century

This frame farmhouse is a two-story, five-bay structure with a steeply pitched central cross gable. The walls are covered with asbestos shingle siding. Windows are spaced slightly unevenly in the front elevation and have two over two pane sashes. The window architraves are plain. The main entrance is located in the central bay, beneath the cross gable giving the house the appearance of symmetry. There is a transom above the door. The most distinctive feature of this house is the one-story hipped roof porch which spans the front elevation. It is supported by turned posts with carved brackets.

The frame farmhouse is a two story, five bay structure with a steeply pitched central cross-gable. The walls are covered with asbestos shingle siding. Windows are spaced slightly unevenly in the front elevation and have 2/2 sash. The window architraves are plain. The main entrance is located in the central bay, beneath the cross-gable giving the house the appearance of symmetry. There is a transom above the door. The most distinctive feature of this house is the one story hipped-roof porch which spans the front elevation. It is supported by turned posts with carved brackets. The roof is covered with wooden shingles and brick chimneys with corbeled tops extend from inside the gable ends. A two story ell is attached at the rear.

Behind the house is a small frame barn and a shed.


