DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This rectangular, frame tobacco barn is covered with a gable roof. The construction comprises a combination of posts and studs. Both horizontal and vertical board siding cover the barn. A southern shed has been added to expand the space in the barn.

The north-facing exposed wall is sheathed with sawn, lapped clapboards placed horizontally. They are reminiscent of river clapboards, but measure about twice as long (c. 8'). A set of double doors is centrally located on this side. A hinged, horizontal ventilator board appears to either side of the doors, several feet above the ground. The barn presently rests on concrete block piers. Standing-seam metal covers the roof.

This barn measures 24' deep by 52' long. The slightly off-center entrance bay is 8' wide. The east room measures 24' wide, while the west room is 20' wide.

Eaves construction includes a tilted false plate pegged into the joists. The rafter feet are notched to pass over the false plate.


