DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This small frame house stands one story tall and measures four bays long. The east-facing gable-roofed building includes a shed addition to the rear.

Three evenly-spaced gabled dormers holding six over six sash light the facade's roof slope. On this side, the left-hand bay is spaced a greater distance away from the other three, evenly-spaced bays. The entrance occupies the second bay from the right. The other three bays hold six over six sash framed in plain flat boards.

A brick stove-flue chimney heats the northwest corner of the addition. Tarpaper covers the roof, while asphalt imitation-brick sheathes the walls.


