DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This frame house is a one and a half story, three bay by one bay gable front structure sheathed with lapped wooden siding. It faces west. Major windows have two over two pane sashes. Flanking a full sized window in the gable are two small six light windows. They are trimmed with plain architraves. The main entrance is located in the center bay of the front or west elevation. There is an interior flue extending from the roof ridge. The roof extends beyond the walls on all sides. Along the flanks of the house the ends of the rafters are exposed.


