This two-story frame house measures five bays wide by one bay deep. A prominent cross-gable distinguishes the facade. The gable-roofed house includes a front porch and a rear kitchen section. 2/2 sash windows light the dwelling.

The main entrance is centered in the front elevation and includes a transom and sidelights around the door. A hipped roof porch extends across the front elevation. It is supported by round posts. Brick chimneys are located inside the gable ends.




